INCUBATION CENTER POLICY

Mission and Vision:

The K.G. Mittal Incubation Center is dedicated to fostering innovation, entrepreneurship, and the development of startups. Our mission is to provide an environment that supports and nurtures early-stage ventures, creating opportunities for student entrepreneurs and the local community.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must be affiliated with Smt. K. G. Mittal College of Arts & Commerce, including current students, alumni, and faculty.
- External applicants may also be considered on a case-by-case basis, subject to approval by the Incubation Center Advisory Committee.

Application and Selection Process:

- Interested applicants must submit a comprehensive Project plan and complete the official application form.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Incubation Center advisory Committee,
 which will evaluate the viability, innovation, and potential impact of each startup.
- Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview and PPT presentation.
- Final selection will be based on the advisory committee's assessment.

Incubation Period:

- The typical incubation period is 6 months, with the possibility of extension based on report and achievements.
- Startups must meet predetermined milestones to continue their incubation beyond the initial period.

Facilities and Resources:

- Incubated startups will have access to office space, co-working facilities, and meeting rooms within the incubation center.
- Additionally, startups will receive mentorship, guidance, and access to Mittal college's network of industry experts and investors.
- Technical resources, such as labs and equipment, may be provided based on specific project needs.

Mentorship and Advisory Services:

- Startups will be paired with mentors and advisors who will provide guidance and expertise.
- Mentoring sessions will be scheduled regularly to monitor progress and address challenges.

Code of Conduct:

 All incubatees are expected to adhere to a code of conduct that promote professionalism, collaboration, and respect for others.

Transparency:

 The incubation center will maintain transparency in its operations, decisionmaking processes, and financial matters.
