OBJECTIVES:

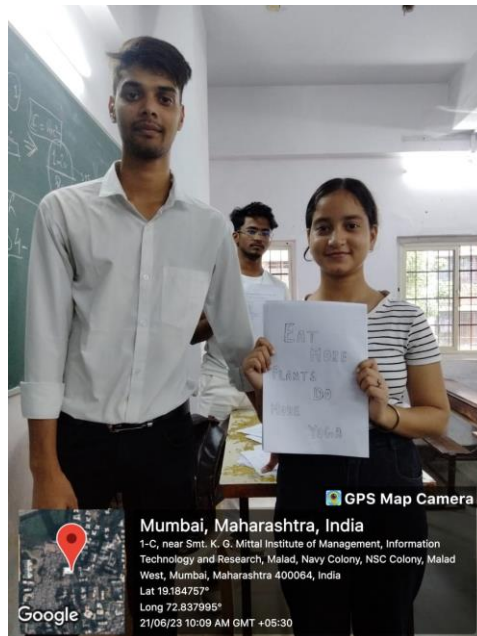
- To nurture students' physical, mental, cultural and spiritual growth by conducting various activities which will ensure holistic development of students.

Total - 68 (Male - 42, Female - 26)



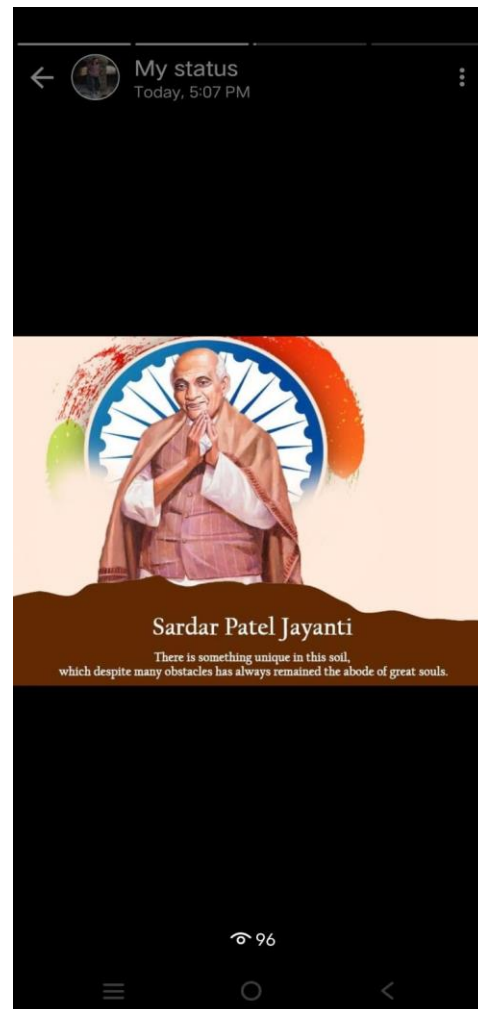
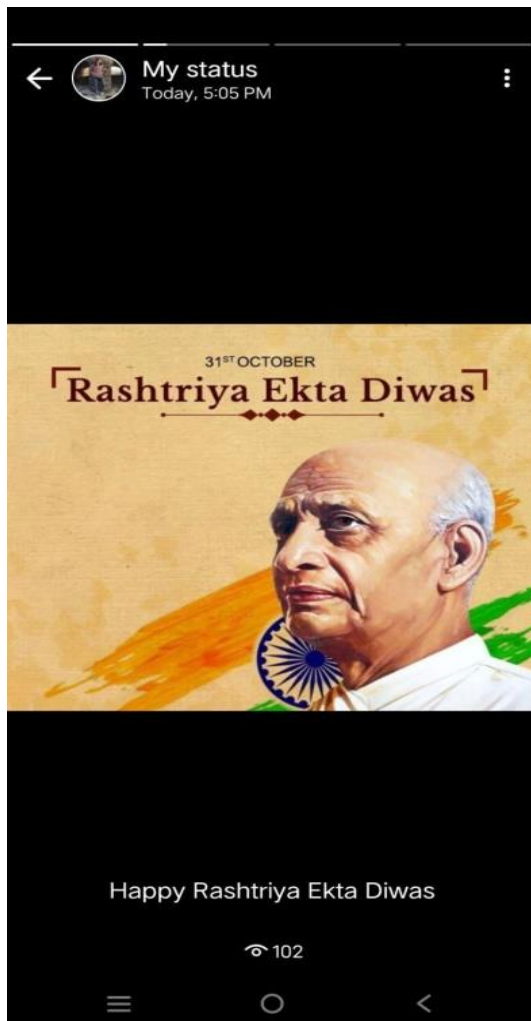

Total -17 (Male -8, Female -9)

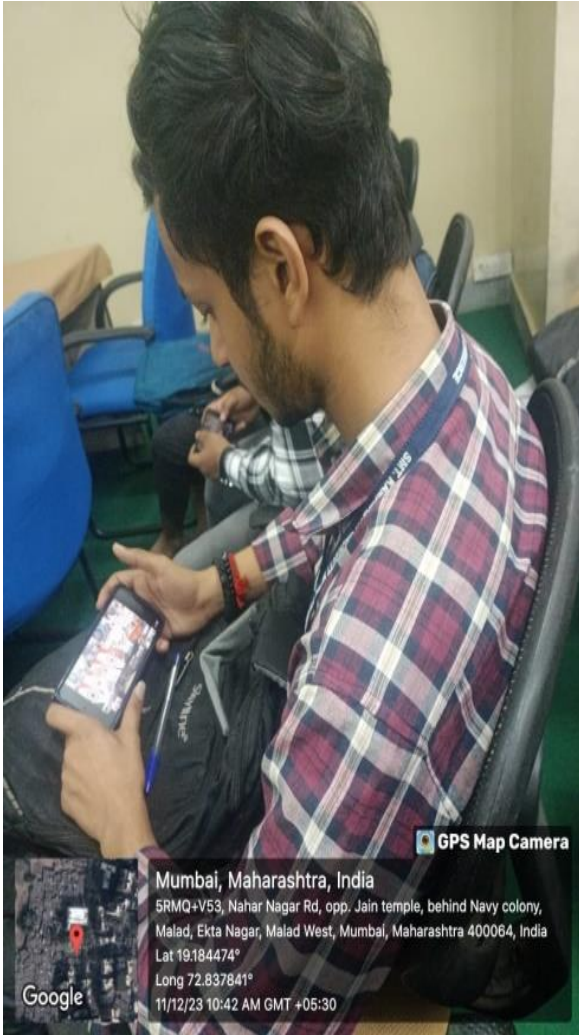
